We meet weekly at the Legion in TRF, except on holidays or during special social events. As a member, you'll receive a weekly email update with details about the upcoming meeting, including the location. Occasionally, we host offsite meetings or social events at our presenter's venue. What to Expect at Our Meetings

Our gatherings are informal, enjoyable, and include lunch. Meetings begin at 12:05 PM with an Invocation, followed by greetings, singing "My Country, 'Tis of Thee," and reciting the Rotary Four-Way Test. Guests are welcomed, and Club business is discussed, often in a lighthearted way with Happy Dollars—a fun segment where members share good news, with contributions supporting local projects.

By 12:30 PM, the guest program starts, and we aim to wrap up by 1:00 PM. Members are encouraged to suggest or host programs. In keeping with Rotary's values, discussions on religion and politics are avoided, as we strive for inclusivity. The Invocation is a personal expression and can be faith-based, inspirational, or tied to current events, provided it remains inclusive.

Beyond the Meetings

Rotary is not just about meetings—it's about community. We organize various social events like picnics, happy hours, golf outings, and holiday parties, with families warmly welcomed. Our focus on community service involves year-round projects, and we value member suggestions for new initiatives.
